

Hannah, Eli & Samuel Sunday School | 10:00-10:45am



CONNECTION of the month

As we begin the new year, here are a few tips to weave faith formation into your daily lives!

- Evaluate your daily rhythms Identify transitions and pauses where you can add prayer, discussion and scripture to your routines.
- Welcome hard questions When this happens, simply say, "I don't know – let's try to find the answer together," and then turn to a pastor, resources or friends to help you unpack challenging topics.
- Offer a blessing Saying a blessing over your child before school or at bedtime, can help them connect deeply with you and God. As you pray, hold or make eye contact with your child to create a special moment.
- **Find connection** Being active in a faith community helps children see their role in the body of Christ. Including young children in worship services broadens their understanding of church and what it means to praise God.




