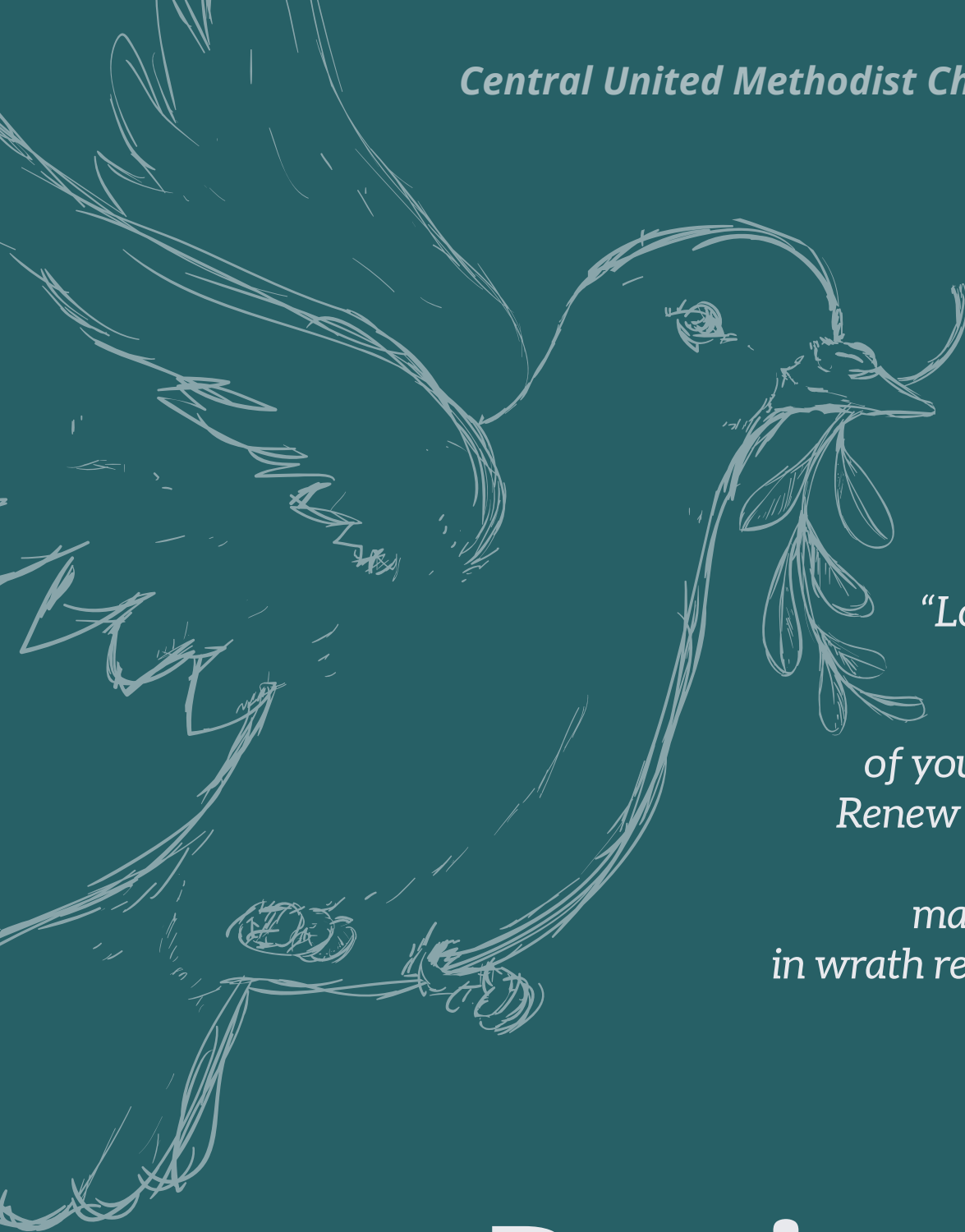

Revive Us Again

In Habakkuk's day, the prophet looked around and saw a world in decline—violence, injustice, and spiritual apathy. But instead of giving up, he lifted his voice in a desperate, faith-filled cry: "LORD, do again what only You can do. Revive Your work in our time!"

This prayer guide is an invitation to echo that same cry in our own lives, homes, the Church and world. As we seek God together, let Habakkuk's prayer become our own. Let us remember what God has done, stand in awe of who He is, and ask with boldness that He would renew His mighty works in our generation.

This guide will help lead you through daily prayers focused on repentance, renewal, unity, and a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit. May it stir within you a deeper hunger for God and a holy expectancy that He still moves today. Let's pray for revival—not just around us, but within us.

Scripture

Reflection

Today's Prayer

A SERVANT-HEARTED CHURCH

Scripture

Mark 10:45

Reflection

Revival calls us out of self-interest into a life of service. A revived church serves joyfully.

Today's Prayer

Scripture

Reflection

The early church prayed and the place was shaken. Revival churches are praying churches.
