General Conference Briefing at Convocation

It is honor and responsibility to be a delegate. It's been 8 years since last General Conference. Conferencing is foundational for Methodists (Charge Conference. Annual. Jurisdictional Then General every four years.)

Delegates determined by your membership of your annual conference. African has grown in size and more representation. Six clergy and six lay delegates represent Holston plus 2 alternates (12 are eligible to vote). 862 Delegates voting. (55.9% US). (32% Africa) (6% Europe) (6% Philippines) .They vote to make changes to book of discipline and book of resolutions. Bishops preside over sessions. Bishops do not have voice or vote. Judicial Council (like supreme court) on site for verdict on questions.

This is similar to the United Nations. They debate 1099 petitions submitted. 14 Legislative Bodies work the 1099 petitions. Delegates choose which specific committee they want to be on. They already have been meeting during zoom. It is very likely the legislation will look different as they are fine tuned, adapted, dropped or taken to floor. They work in legislative committees. 2nd week is livestreamed. People can go and sit in stands in Charlotte.

Some votes will need simple majority. Constitutional change takes 2/3rd majority then ratified by annual conferences. Not sure if this will be at this year's annual conference or not.

Hiahliahts

- Revise Social Principles every eight years. Social Principles are who we are as a body as a denomination. Revised social principles are available online.
- Regionalization. Ability for conferences to adapt the book of disciple for their settings and context. The US cannot do that currently.
- Human Sexuality Woven throughout many pieces of legislation. Performing Same Sex Weddings. Ordination.
- Budget Always tough but more difficult after 7000+ churches have disaffiliated.
